HOLOKU BALL 2005

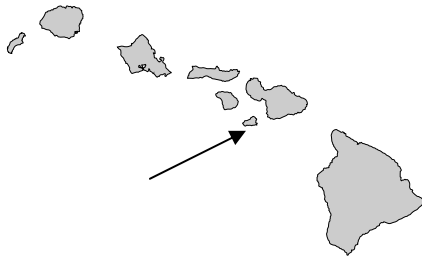

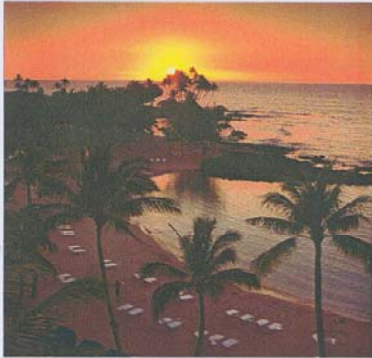
TOUR OF KAWAI NUI MARSH PLANTS

Rick Barboza of **Hui Ku Maoli Ola**, owner of the native plant nursery, will conduct a tour of Kawai Nui Marsh plants on Saturday February 5 from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm. On site visits will be to Ulupo Heiau and Na Pohaku O Hauwahine where native plant restoration projects have taken place for the past seven years. The tour will involve car-pooling and walking to different areas in Kawai Nui Marsh and ending at the Hui Ku Maoli Ola nursery in Waimanalo where plants can be purchased and questions answered about plant propagation. The tour is co-sponsored by **Ahahui Malama I Ka Lokahi**, the **Ko'olaupoko Hawaiian Civic Club** and the **Kawai Nui Heritage Foundation**. Donations of \$5 will be accepted.
