The tourists and local people along the way had a nice time enjoying Kealoha's ukulele playing and with her dancers doing the hula.

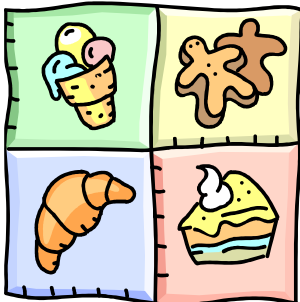
At the Prince Kuhio statue **T. B. Lyons** led the group in He Lei No Honolulu and the flowers used on the convertible were left as ho'okupu.
