Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs Scholarship

A Native Hawaiian Serving Institution

Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs Scholarship

Chaminade University, as a Native Hawaiian Serving Institution, has enjoyed a special relationship with the Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs. In recognition of its partnership, Chaminade University is offering the new Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs Scholarship. Open to members or dependents of active members of a Hawaiian Civic Club, there are two award types: 1) for first year day students who are members, or dependents of members, who reside in the continental U.S. (i.e. mainland) at the time of application; and, 2) for first year and transfer day students who are members, or dependents of members, who are Hawai'i-based. This award is renewable for up to three additional years.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Students should apply through the Office of Admissions.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

For Mainland-Based HCC Members – First Year Student 1. Be a member or dependent of an active member of a Hawaiian Civic Club living on the mainland. 2. Be accepted into Chaminade University as an unconditionally admitted full-time first-year day student with a high school cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. 3. Be charged the maximum full-time, undergraduate day student tuition for the academic year.

For Hawai'i-Based HCC Members – First Year Student 1. Be a member or dependent of an active member of a Hawaiian Civic Club living in Hawai'i. 2. Be accepted into Chaminade University as an unconditionally admitted full-time day student with a high school cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher. For Hawai'i-Based HCC Members – Transfer Student

- 1. Be a member or dependent of an active member of a Hawaiian Civic Club living in Hawaii.
- 2. Have completed an associates degree and be unconditionally admitted to Chaminade as a full-time transfer day student with a cumulative GPA from previous colleges of at least 2.5 or higher.
- 3. Be charged the maximum full-time, undergraduate day student tuition for the academic year.

AWARD AMOUNT

For Mainland-Based HCC Members The award is the value of one half of the full-time day tuition for the academic year. Awards are credited against the recipient's tuition charges. For Hawai'i-Based HCC Members – First Year Students The award is \$4,500 to \$6,000.00 for the academic year (\$2,250 to \$3,000 per semester). Awards are credited against the recipient's tuition charges. For Hawai'i-Based HCC Members – Transfer Students The award is \$6,000 per year (\$3,000 per semester). Awards are credited against the recipient's tuition charges.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

Recipients are required to complete twenty (20) hours of community service per academic year to a Hawaiian civic club, island Council, Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs or Hawaii Maoli.

DEADLINE

Applications should be submitted prior to the start of the semester for which the student intends to enroll.
