With some member's support our fundraiser to help borne costs for the delegates was successful and I personally want to send a "BIG MAHALO" to those who supported our efforts.

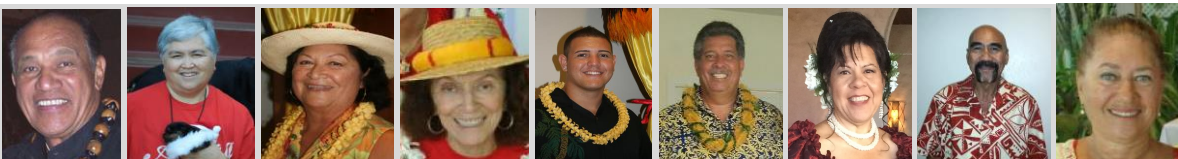
